




Leading Economic indicators










The Shape of the Yield Curve





Elections and the Markets



- No meaningful performance difference in election years – unless in recession like 2008
- Performance stronger during the second half of the year
- S&P 500 Returns under:
 - Democratic Presidents = 9.7%
 - Republican Presidents = 6.7%



The Perils of Index Funds



- Big marketing dollars towards "low cost" funds
- S&P 500 Index has good, average and bad stocks
- Index performance = average of the market
- S&P 500 currently has:
 - 87 stocks with NEGATIVE 5 year earnings growth
 - 54 stocks with 5 year earnings growth OVER 25%
- Own some of the good 54 stocks and avoid the bad
 87 to work towards better performance!
